



Brink's Foundation 150th Anniversary Scholarship Program Fact Sheet

ELIGIBILITIES

Applicants must be high school seniors or students in final year of secondary public or charter school within the city of Chicago, Illinois, who plan to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or four-year college or university, or into an accredited vocational-technical school in the United States or Canada.

AWARDS

The program will utilize standard Scholarship America recipient selection procedures, including the consideration of past academic performance and future potential, leadership and participation in school and community activities, work experience, statement of career and educational aspirations and goals, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal. Financial need will not be considered.

Employees and children of The Brink's Company and its subsidiaries will not be eligible for this program.

The authorized distribution for new awards is \$150,000. Up to 150 awards of \$1,000 each will be granted. The awards will be distributed as follows:

- Awards are for one year only.
- Awards are for undergraduate study only.

Scholarship America will send application and announcement materials to guidance counselors at each school. Awards will be determined in early May and the winners will be announced before the end of that month.
